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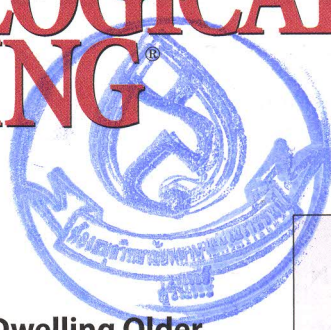
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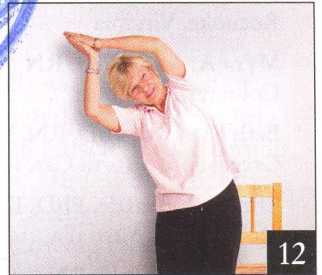

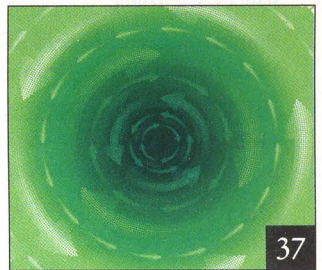
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Struggle Between Survival and Death: The Life Experiences of Taiwanese Older Adults with Suicidal Ideation
