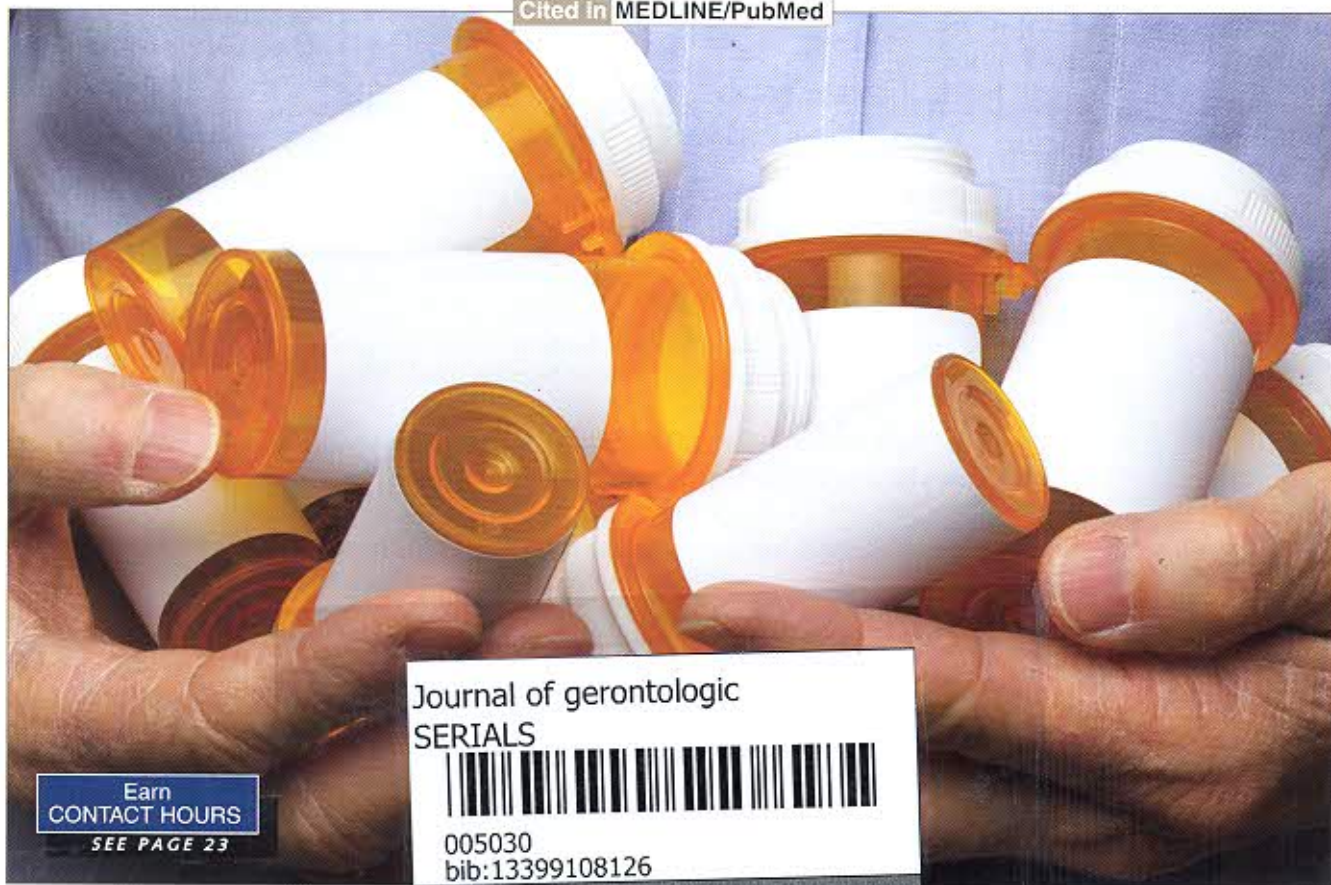

Prevalence of Advance Directives Among Older Adults Admitted to Intensive Care Units and Requiring Mechanical Ventilation

In a population of 450 critically ill older adults requiring mechanical ventilation in two Mid-Atlantic hospitals, the prevalence of advance directive completion was only 24%, suggesting a need for greater awareness and education.
