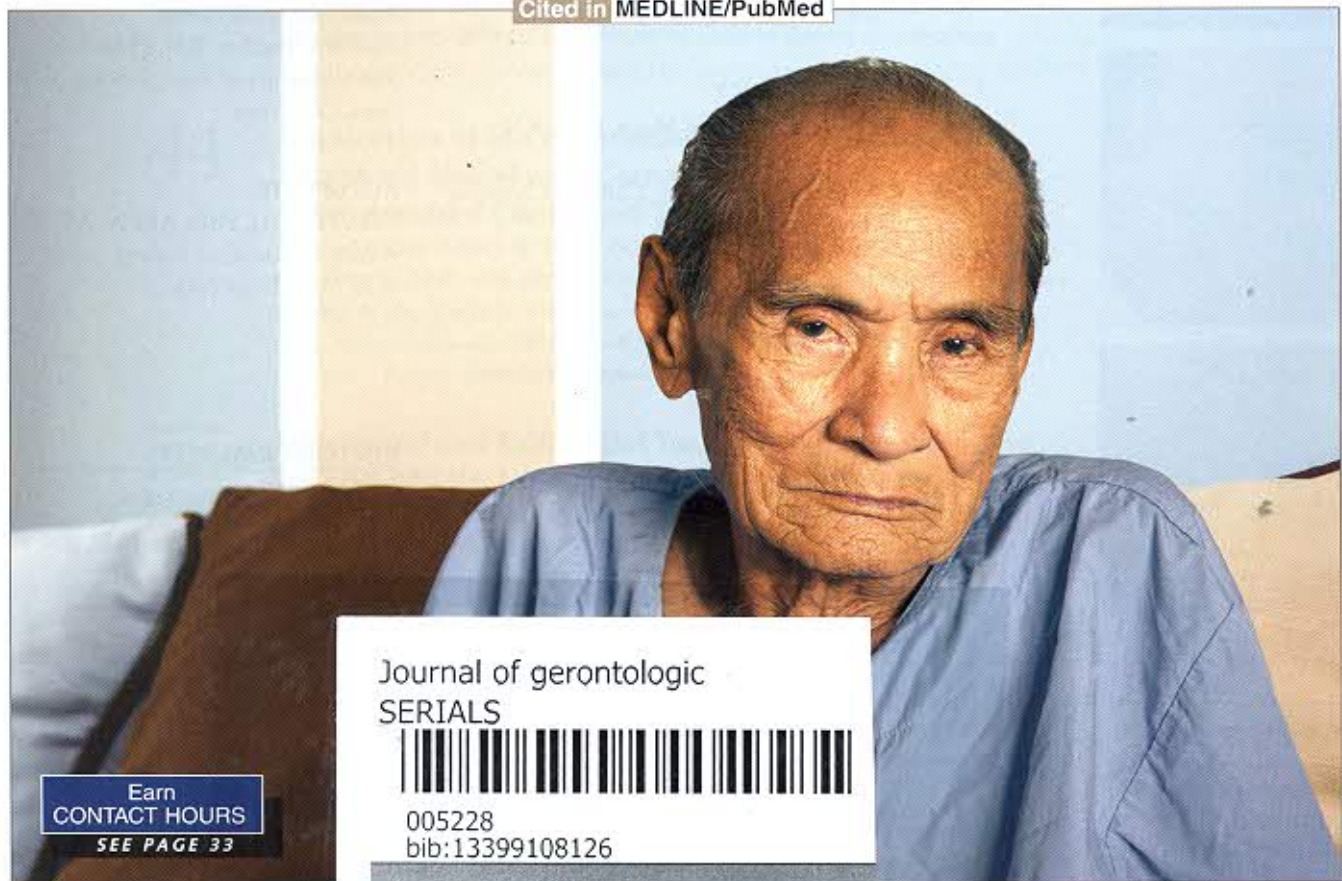

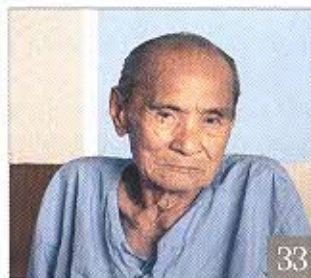

A systematic literature review revealed that sarcopenia is correlated with poor nutritional status; however, comparison of study results were complicated by the lack of a generally accepted definition for sarcopenia and different instruments used to detect its presence.

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## Application of the Progressively Lowered Stress Threshold Model with Community-Based Caregivers: A Randomized Controlled Trial
