39 **Packed Red Blood Cell Transfusion in Older Adults: A Systematic Review**

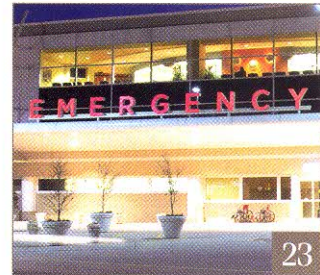

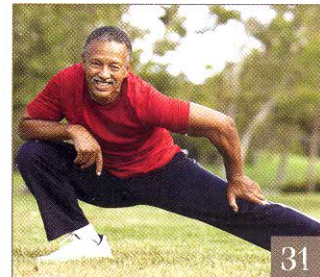

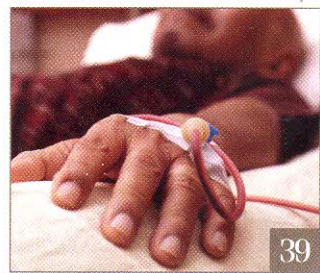
