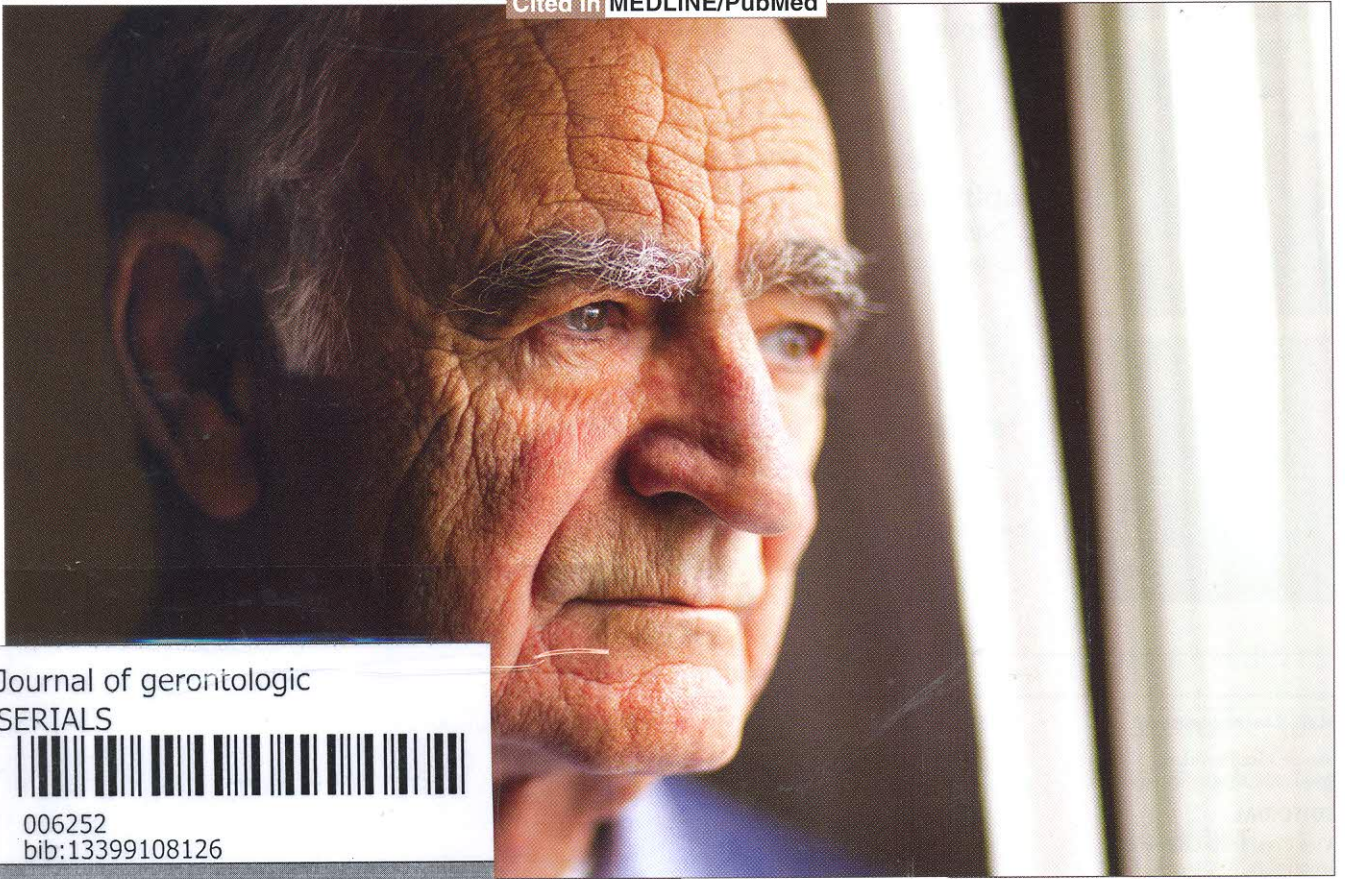

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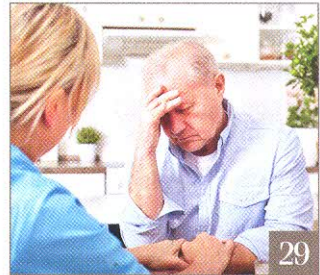

Trust and reciprocity, communication, sharing a common goal, and support from management were found to be critical factors for effective teamwork.

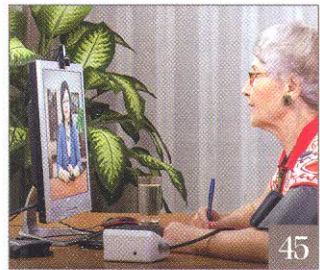
